Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ► A Bachillerato (completed 12 years of education) with an average mark of 7/10 or 70% plus a recognised Foundation programme with good grades.
- Successfully completed the first year of a Mexican University degree (Licenciado) with good grades in relevant subjects.
- Students who have not completed a year at university level will be expected to undertake a foundation or bridging programme, for example the INTO Queen's <u>International Foundation</u>
 <u>Programme</u>, before they can be admitted to an undergraduate degree programme.
- Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. Course Finder

The comparable Mexican qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

▶ A four-year Licenciado or Professional Title with 8.0 (bien).

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

► A four-year Licenciado or Professional Title with 7.0 (suficiente).
