

QUB Admission Requirements Nigeria



Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- West African Examinations Council (WAEC) or the Nigerian Examinations Council (NECO) Senior School Certificate plus successful completion of a recognised Foundation programme with good grades.
- Applicants who have successfully completed the first year of a Nigerian University Bachelor Degree will be considered for admission.
- Between 30 and 36 points in the IBD.
- West African GCE A-Levels or UK A-Levels.

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Nigerian qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A good Bachelor degree awarded by a recognised Nigerian university with 'second class, upper division' and minimum CGPA 3.5/5.0.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A good Bachelor degree awarded by a recognised Nigerian university with 'second class, lower division' and minimum CGPA 3.0/5.0.

English language Requirements

- WASSCE / NECO with a minimum of C6 accepted for most programmes.
