QUB Admission Requirements Pakistan



Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- Intermediate/Higher Education Secondary School Examinations (Year 12) with good grades plus a recognised Foundation programme.
- Completion of a two or three-year Bachelor degree with a first division (60%+).
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB).

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. Course Finder

The comparable Pakistani qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- A 4-year undergraduate degree from an HEC recognised institution with a minimum of 70% or GPA 3.0/4.
- ► A 2 or 3-year Bachelor degree with a minimum of 60% plus a Masters degree with 70% may be considered on an individual basis.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ► A 4-year undergraduate degree from an HEC recognised institution with a minimum of 60% or GPA 2.8/4.
- ► A 2 or 3-year Bachelor degree with a minimum of 55% plus a Masters degree with 60% may be considered on an individual basis.

English Language Requirements:

- Many iGCSE syllabi and GCE O-Level in English language are accepted
- ► IELTS or an equivalent acceptable qualification: English Langua Requirements
