Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- If you hold a Tawjihiyah (General Secondary Education Certificate) with a minimum of 75% plus a recognised Foundation/bridging programme.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma (IB). Information on required grades.

INTO Queen's offers a range of academic and English language programmes to help prepare international students for undergraduate study at Queen's University.

These programmes are designed for international students who do not meet the required academic and English language requirements for direct entry.

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. Course Finder

The comparable Saudi Arabian qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

▶ A good Bachelor degree awarded by a recognised institution with a GPA of 3.75/5.0, or GPA 3.0/4.0 or an overall average of at least 75%.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

▶ A good Bachelor degree awarded by a recognised institution with a GPA of 3.5/5.0 or GPA 2.8/4.0 or an overall average of at least 70%.

English Language Requirements:
