

# QUB Admission Requirements Singapore



## Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- ▶ Singapore/Cambridge GCE A-Level Examinations in a minimum of three subjects.
- ▶ SIPCAL examinations will also be considered for admission (all subjects at H2 level).
- ▶ Applicants who have completed a three-year diploma at a Singapore Polytechnic may be considered for advanced entry to the second year of some undergraduate programmes (in particular Engineering and Biomedical Science). In general, a minimum B grade average (CGPA 3.0/4) or better in the Polytechnic Diploma is required for entry to second year, and relevant subjects must have been covered in the Diploma.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma .

## Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. [Course Finder](#)

The comparable Singaporean qualifications are as follows:

### UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

- ▶ A good Bachelor degree from a recognised Singaporean university with CGPA 3.0 or above.

### UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

- ▶ A good Bachelor degree from a recognised Singaporean university with CGPA 2.8 or above.

## English Language Requirements:

- ▶ O-Level English 1127/1128 syllabus with a minimum of C accepted for most programmes.
- ▶ Many iGCSE & O-Level syllabi in English language are accepted
