QUB Admission Requirements Thailand

Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- The Certificate of Secondary Education (Maw 6) with good grades, plus a recognised Foundation programme such as our 9-month Foundation Course at INTO Queen's.
- Matayom 5 High School students with a GPA of 2.5+ can undertake our 9month <u>Foundation Course at INTO Queen's</u> that leads to Year 1 of an undergraduate degree.
- Matayom 6 High School students with a GPA of 3.0+ can undertake our <u>International Year One</u> course at INTO Queen's that leads to Year 2 of an undergraduate degree in Business, Economics and Finance or Engineering related subjects.
- Applicants who have completed one or two years of University study may be eligible for admission to Stage One, if relevant subjects have been studied and strong grades achieved.

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. <u>Course Finder</u>

The comparable Thai qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

A good Bachelor degree from a recognised Thai university with minimum GPA or 3.0/4.0 - 3.2/4.0. Entry requirements will vary depending on the Institution attended.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

A good Bachelor degree from a recognised Thai university with minimum GPA 2.8/4.0 - 2.9/4.0. Entry requirements will vary depending on the Institution attended.

NB: The higher GPA required from all other universities including Rajabhat Universities and Rajamangla Institutes of Technology.

English Language Requirements:

- Many iGCSE & O-Level syllabi in English language are accepted
- IELTS or an equivalent acceptable qualification: English Language Required
