QUB Admission Requirements Vietnam



Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- The Bang Tot Nghiep Pho Thong Trung Hoc (Upper Secondary School Graduation Certificate) with good grades, plus a recognised Foundation/Bridging programme.
- Year 11 High School students with a GPA of 7.0+ can undertake our 9-month Foundation Course at INTO Queen's that leads to Year 1 of an undergraduate degree
- ► Year 12 High School students with a GPA of 7.0+ can undertake our 9-month Diploma course at INTO Queen's that leads to Year 2 of an undergraduate degree in Finance or Engineering
- Applicants who have successfully completed the first year of a Vietnamese University degree (Tot Nghiep Dai Hoc) in a relevant subject will be considered for admission to the first year of undergraduate degree programmes.

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. Course Finder

The comparable Vietnamese qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

A good Bachelor degree (Bằng Tốt Nghiệp Đại Học / Bằng Cử Nhân) from a recognised Vietnamese university with a minimum score of 7.0/10 or 70%.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

A good Bachelor degree (Bằng Tốt Nghiệp Đại Học / Bằng Cử Nhân) from a recognised Vietnamese university with a minimum score of 6.0/10 or 60%.

English Language Requirements:

- Many iGCSE & O-Level syllabi in English language are accepted
