Entry Requirements for Undergraduate:

- → 3 Zimbabwean A-Levels. The grades required vary from AAA to BBB depending on the programme.
- ▶ 3 UK A-Levels.
- ▶ Between 30 and 36 points in the International Baccalaureate Diploma

Entry Requirements for Postgraduate (Taught):

Entry to taught masters programmes at Queen's University Belfast usually require either a UK upper second-class (2:1) or a lower second-class (2:2) undergraduate degree. For most courses the content of your Bachelor degree may also be considered. Please check our Course Finder for detailed entry requirements. Course Finder

The comparable Zimbabwean qualifications are as follows:

UK Upper Second-Class Honours (2:1)

A good Bachelor Honours degree from a recognised institution with grades of 2:1, 65%, B++ or above.

UK Lower Second-Class Honours (2:2)

A good Bachelor Honours degree from a recognised institution with grades of 2:2, 60-64%, B+ or above.

English Language Requirements:

- ► IELTS or an equivalent acceptable qualification: English Language Requirements
- Zimbabwe GCE O-Level with a minimum of C accepted for most programmes.
