English language entry requirements

For degree courses that require IELTS 6.5 (with a minimum of 5.5 in each subskill) for direct entry:

8 weeks: IELTS 6.0 (with a minimum of 5.5 in three subskills and 5.0 in one subskill) or equivalent
12 weeks: IELTS 5.5 (with a minimum of 5.0 in any subskill) or equivalent

For degree courses that require IELTS 6.0 (with a minimum of 5.5 in each subskill) for direct entry:

8 weeks: IELTS 5.5 (with a minimum of 5.0 in any subskill) or equivalent
12 weeks: IELTS 5.0 (with a minimum of 5.0 in any subskill) or equivalent

Please ensure you consult Queen's University Belfast for details of the English language level required for entry onto your chosen course.

Tuition fees

- Completed application form, signed by the student or the parent/legal guardian.
- A copy of your university offer letter.
- Copy(ies) of English language certificate(s) in English.
- Full details of previous study in the UK.
- A copy of your passport.

After carefully reviewing your application, if successful, we will send you a formal offer of a place. For complete applications, this is usually within two working days.

You will need to return your signed acceptance letter, send us your tuition fee deposit (as detailed in your offer letter) and meet all conditions of the offer to begin your course.
