Notes

- i. Students may remain in the same accommodation during the Christmas vacation and the cost is included in the fee quoted.
- ii. Students may remain in the same accommodation during the Easter vacation, and the cost is included in the fee quoted.
- iii. Some students may be required to vacate Elms Village accommodation over the Easter Vacation to facilitate conferences. Notification will be given to these students by 28 February 2009 and fees will be adjusted accordingly, with rebates given to any student who has paid their residential fees in advance.
- iv. Students resident in semester one, who apply to remain in residence for semester two, will be required to pay for the inter-semester period, ie from 26 January 2008.
- v. Vacation residence for those students who require temporary accommodation while seeking accommodation in the private sector will only be available up to 13 September 2008. After this date you must either move out or take up an accommodation contract within University accommodation.

Accommodation during the International Students' Orientation Programme

The residential year for University accommodation begins on 20 September 2008. For students attending the Orientation Programme on 18 and 19 September, University accommodation will be available from 15-19 September inclusive at a fixed rate cost for the 5 days. This gives students the flexibility to arrive between 15 and 17 September, to take advantage of the free welcome and transfer service from the two Belfast airports. Note that this option is only available to students who have reserved a place in University accommodation for at least the first semester of the academic year.

Students wishing to attend the orientation programme who have opted to live in private accommodation during the semester should make alternative arrangements. Please contact Queen's International if you require assistance.
