

In-sessional English Language Programme

INTO Queen's University offers a programme of language support to Queen's University students whose native language is not English. The in-sessional programme provides free English language classes aimed at helping international students improve their English in order to successfully follow their academic courses. Please note that the programme does **not** provide courses for students who are already at a very advanced level of English.

The standard course fee is £100. A concessionary fee of £80 will be applied to those who are unemployed, on income support, retired, au pairs or a student at another university. To receive the concessionary rate, please bring evidence of your status when you pay your fee.

For Erasmus students, exchange students and those studying full-time at QUB on award bearing courses and paying full International fees, an administration and books/course materials fee of £25 is charged.

At the time of registration, students will be asked to indicate their first choice of course. Where possible, INTO Queen's will endeavour to accommodate all students' first choices, but where this is not possible, students will be offered an alternative course. Although priority will be given to allocating students their first choice of course, students may attend more than one course if there is space in the class. Any student wishing to do so should ask to be put on the waiting list for their second/third choice.

Students should pay full course fees at the time of registration. Payment can be made by cash or credit card.

Classes will have a maximum of 16 students and will not run with less than 8 students.

Testing and Registration

All Queen's students **must** bring copies of their English language qualifications/certificates on the day of registration. Students who do not have a recognised test certificate will be required to take a short test to assess their level.

Students who have already completed an INTO Queen's in-sessional course in 2011 should bring their attendance certificate.

At the time of registration you must provide:

- your student identity (ID) card
- your e-mail (university e-mail) address
- copies of your language qualifications or in-sessional course certificate

Courses Available

Information on day, time and venue will be released at the end of September.

1. Seminar Skills

This course is for students who wish to develop their spoken grammar and vocabulary with regard to academic situations. Students will develop confidence and will be better equipped to make contributions during seminars, and will also improve their presentation skills.

2. Language Development

This course is for students who would like to improve their English in a more general context. It aims to develop communicative skills and powers of self-expression. The four skills of reading, writing, speaking and listening are focused on along with grammatical accuracy.

3. Academic Writing

This is designed for students who need to improve their ability to write clear and accurate academic English. It will focus on various aspects of academic writing depending on the level, including basic sentence structure, paragraph organisation, cohesion, coherence and referencing.
