| Exceptional Progression Award | School of Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering | £500 | Student progressing to Year Two within the School of Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering with the highest academic mark |
| Exceptional Progression Award | Queen's Management School | £250 | Student progressing to Queen's Management School with the highest academic mark (including both UG and PG) |

Only students' academic average grades will be assessed for prize purposes. If two or more students' grades are the highest, then English overall grades will be taken into consideration. If they are also the same, students will share the prize and be awarded a certificate each.
