Jeffrey C. Alexander is the Lillian Chavenson Saden Professor of Sociology at Yale University and codirector of the Center for Cultural Sociology. A theorist working in the areas of politics, culture and aesthetics, he has devoted himself to problems of democracy, solidarity and incorporation. In *Trauma: A Social Theory* (2012), Alexander conceptualises performances of reconciliation and alienation as responses to cataclysmic events. Currently, he is engaged in a series of conference and book projects that aim to globalise the sociological approach to democracy developed in his *The Civil Sphere* (2006). The first volume, *The Civil Sphere in Latin America*, is now in press. Alexander's most recent work is *The Drama of Social Life* (2017).
