JOINING INSTRUCTIONS

We've put together some instructions to make it easy for you to join us at any online event that we host on the **Microsoft Teams** platform.

SMART PHONE

Download the Microsoft Teams App (note: do not create a new account as this may charge you).

- Once downloaded, leave the App and and click on the event link we've provided
- This will open the App. Select "Join as quest", enter your full name and join meeting
- This will add you to the lobby. Please wait and we will admit you shortly before the event starts
- Once the event is finished you can delete the App if you prefer.

COMPUTER

Note: If you are using an Apple Mac then use the smart phone instructions above.

- You will not need to download the App for your desktop
- Click on the event link we've provided
- The link should open in your browser and give you two options:

- Select "Join on the web instead"
- You can choose if you want to allow Microsoft Teams to have access to your camera and microphone. Please decline as it's better for everyone to keep their camera off.
