Industry Links

Real-world consultancy project option. Students can choose an MBA project tailored to their interests. Students spend time working with the client organisation to deliver effective solutions. Full training and academic supervision are provided. Consulting Challenge: As part of a team students work with partners from industry to solve practical business challenges incorporating ideas from class, preparing an Executive Board presentation at the end.

Career Development

Integrated career development: One-on-one coaching, Personal CV analysis, career advice and interview skills training. Leadership Skills: A year-long programme of workshops provides training in personal development, emotional intelligence, challenging conversations, coaching and conflict resolution. Individual coaching to help students identify and work on their career / personal development challenges.

Entry Criteria

Normally a 2.1 Honours degree or
equivalent qualification acceptable
to the University in any discipline.
Applicants with qualifications below
2.1 Honours degree standard may be
considered on a case-by-case basis
if they can demonstrate appropriate
relevant professional experience.

Applicants should have a minimum
of three years' quality professional
experience. Internships, a sandwich
year, part-time or temporary
work will not be considered.

Applicants must provide a full and
up-to-date **Curriculum Vitae** including
a full work history. The work history
should include the employer's name and
address, job title and brief description
of duties and responsibilities, as
well as the start and end dates for
each period of employment.



In addition, applicants are required to
submit a **video** statement of not less than
3 minutes and no more than 5 minutes
duration. Your video can be uploaded to
any publicly accessible sharing service
(e.g. Youtube, Vimeo, Dropbox). Please
provide a direct link to the video along
with your application. You must ensure
the link is working before submitting your
application. The applicant must be visible
in the video. The video statement should
address the 3 questions below in full. Please
make sure that all questions are covered
in your statement. Generic responses that
do not directly address the questions may
result in your application being rejected.

1. Why you have chosen Queen's
Belfast for your MBA
2. The skills and knowledge you can
offer to peer-learning experiences
as an MBA student at Queen's
3. Your career ambitions and what
you expect to do after graduating
with an MBA from Queen's

English Language Requirements

Evidence of an IELTS* score of 6.5, with
not less than 5.5 in any component, or
an equivalent qualification acceptable
to the University is required.

*Taken within the last 2 years

Application Deadline

Applicants are advised to apply as early
as possible and ideally no later than
16th August 2024 (although we would
recommend international applicants
apply much earlier, to allow time to
apply for a visa). *In the event that any
programme receives a high number of
applications, the University reserves the
right to close the application portal.*
