CUTTING-EDGE FACILITIES

The School of AEL boasts world-class facilities across six sites within walking distance of the main campus. The newest, **Queen’s MediaLab**, is an interdisciplinary research facility championing the convergence of art, design, technology and the metaverse. The **Seamus Heaney Centre** is a world-leading centre for creative writing and poetry. Students also use and study in **SARC**, a newly upgraded Sonic Laboratory with 3D sound, also with edit and broadcast suites; **Drama and Film Centre** (combining the **Brian Friel Theatre**, **Film Studio** and **Queen’s Film Theatre**); **Music Building**, including performance halls, practice and recording suites; and the **McClay Library** which is one of Europe’s best (physical and digital).
