The School of AEL boasts world-class facilities within walking distance of the main campus. The newest, Queen's **MediaLab**, is an interdisciplinary research facility that champions the bringing together of art, design, technology and the metaverse. **The Seamus Heaney Centre** is a world-leading centre for creative writing and poetry. Students also use and study in **SARC**, a newly upgraded Sonic Laboratory with 3D sound, also with edit and broadcast suites; **Drama and Film Centre** (combining the **Brian Friel Theatre**, **Film Studio** and **Queen's Film Theatre**); **Music Building**, including performance halls, practice and recording suites. The **McClay Library** is one of Europe's best (physical and digital).
