GUIDANCE NOTES

All students from Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland entering the University for the first time to undertake a primary degree in a STEM subject, as detailed below, and who have achieved at least three 'A' grades at A-Level or the equivalent in alternative qualifications, are eligible to enter the STEM Performance Awards competition.

The recipients are determined on the basis of their three best A-Level marks or equivalent as determined by the Admissions and Access Service and the <u>onus will be on each applicant</u> to forward the <u>documentary evidence of their results</u> by the closing date of 4.30pm on Friday 11 November 2016.

The criteria for STEM Performance Awards is set out below:

- If you made Queen's your firm choice in your UCAS application, attained a minimum of three 'A' grades at A-level (or equivalent in alternative qualifications) and are enrolled in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics subject, you will be considered for one of 50 £1,000 scholarships in your first year of study.
- You must be enrolled on an undergraduate course in the following Schools:
 - Biological Sciences
 - Chemistry and Chemical Engineering
 - Electronics, Electrical Engineering and Computer Science
 - Mathematics and Physics
 - Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering
 - Medicine, Dentistry and Biomedical Sciences (Biomedical Sciences courses only)
 - Natural and Built Environment (Civil Engineering courses only)
- The top 50 students will be selected on academic performance as determined by Queen's Admissions Service.
- The award is subject to successful completion of semester 1 of first year. All applicants will be notified during the week beginning 13 February 2017 and successful students will receive their scholarships in March 2017.

Notes for completion of the form:

Q4: You should specify your <u>University</u> email address e.g. <u>example@qub.ac.uk</u>.

Q6: Your student number should be issued at Enrolment and Registration during the University's Welcome Week, 19-23 September 2016.

Q7: 'School' refers to University School e.g. School of Biological Sciences.

Q8. 'Course' refers to the programme of study on which you are enrolled, i.e. BSc (Hons) Biochemistry.

Q10: Copies of your results or certificates detailing grades and marks must be attached to your completed application form. If you have not received copies of your uniform marks, they can be obtained by contacting the relevant Examination Board. Photocopies will not be returned unless you request this.

Please note that failure to submit complete sets of uniform marks before the closing date will result in the withdrawal of your application.

No applications will be accepted after the deadline of 4.30pm on Friday 11 November 2016.
