

Queen's Accommodation Covid-19 guidance

Households

It is important as you move into Queen's Accommodation that you understand what constitutes as a 'household'.

- Elms BT9 – Ash Avenue, Holly Grove, Sycamore Park, Rowan Gardens, Oak Avenue, Beech Grove, Chestnut Crescent and also Grant House – each floor in these buildings is considered a 'household';
- Willow Walk – each apartment is considered a 'household';
- Queen's Houses – to include 76 Malone Road, College Gardens and Mount Charles, each house is considered a 'household';
- Elms BT1 / Elms BT2 – each apartment is considered a 'household'.

Current restrictions in Northern Ireland

Up to **15 people** from no more than **four households** can meet in a private home. Please remember it is everyone's responsibility to adhere to government guidance / regulations. Based on these guidelines we will not be allowing guests to stay overnight in Queen's Accommodation.

Remember you should keep rooms well-ventilated, maintain social distancing as much as possible and wash hands well and often.

Queen's Accommodation Guest Policy

Currently Queen's Accommodation are operating a no guest policy (a review of this will take place in December 2021). This to help prevent the spread of the virus and to allow us to manage any outbreaks of Covid-19. We do encourage students to meet up with friends outdoors, to maintain social distancing and to avail of asymptomatic testing across campus and also the on-campus walk-in vaccination centres as detailed below.

On-Campus Walk-in Covid-19 Vaccination Centre

Queen's is working with the Belfast Health and Social Care Trust and the Public Health Agency to support and encourage students to get vaccinated against COVID-19.

To make this as easy as possible, we have arranged **on-campus walk-in vaccination centres** for any students who have not yet received their first jab.

No appointment necessary. Just bring your photographic ID and proof of address (for example, a bill or letter from the University).

The more of us who are vaccinated, the more it helps reduce transmission and the health consequences if you do catch the virus. It is therefore important to get vaccinated as soon as possible. By getting vaccinated, students will be playing a vital part in getting society back to normal and reducing the threat of disruption to education and all aspects of student life.
