



Flicker/ Legacy of Landscape: The People & Heritage of Lough Erne page step by step

1. Go to: <https://identity.flickr.com/sign-up>
2. Fill in relevant information as shown below:



3. You will be asked to confirm your email address by clicking on the link supplied though the Flickr email conformation. (If you can't see the email in your inbox please remember to check the junk folder).




4. Once this is completed you will be asked to sign again using your email and password.. Select whether you accept or reject cookies for the site (this is at the user preference) after this your account is created




7. Click "Choose photos or videos to upload" and select image.



8. When you have selected image, you are then able to add:
 - a. Add a description
 - b. Add tags relating to the image e.g. location etc.
 - c. Tag people
 - d. Add to your personal album
 - e. Add to groups (you must select this to add to the Legacy of Landscape: The People & Heritage of Lough Erne page.)



9. Select Group - Legacy of Landscape: The People & Heritage of Lough Erne page



10. You will now see your image uploaded to the group.
