

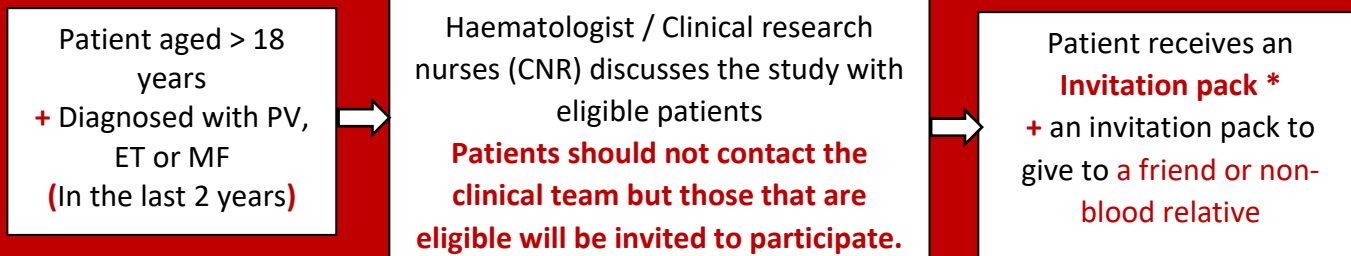
The MOSAICC Plan

What is the MOSAICC Study?

The MOSAICC study aims to determine why some people develop Myeloproliferative Neoplasms (MPNs) including polycythaemia vera (PV), essential thrombocythaemia (ET) or myelofibrosis (MF). These occur when there is an over production of red/white blood cells or platelets but their causes remain unknown. The study will also assess the quality of life of people living with a MPN in order to help improve the lives of people living with these conditions.
