“Comparative effectiveness of regimens for diabetes treatment- What should we do after metformin?”

Dr Roumie has developed research programs related to comparative effectiveness research designed to improve health outcomes by developing evidence-based information for patients, clinicians, and decision-makers about the most effective interventions for patients. A major focus of Dr Roumie’s work has been in the development and implementation of a research portfolio that evaluates appropriate medication utilization as a barrier to optimal patient outcomes and as risk factors for cardiovascular disease. Dr Roumie has been a leader in the field of medication prescribing and cardiovascular epidemiology and improvement. She has participated in multiple expert committees on appropriate medication prescribing, including the Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality Diabetes Multi-Center Research Consortium Executive Committee and the Veterans Health Administration Geriatrics Pharmacy task force on appropriate prescribing, and serves as a member of the Council of Quality and Outcomes Research for the American Heart Association. She is a standing member of the Food and Drug Administration’s Non-prescription Drugs Advisory Committee (NDAC) and was recently nominated as the chairwoman.
