Children with CP are born prematurely

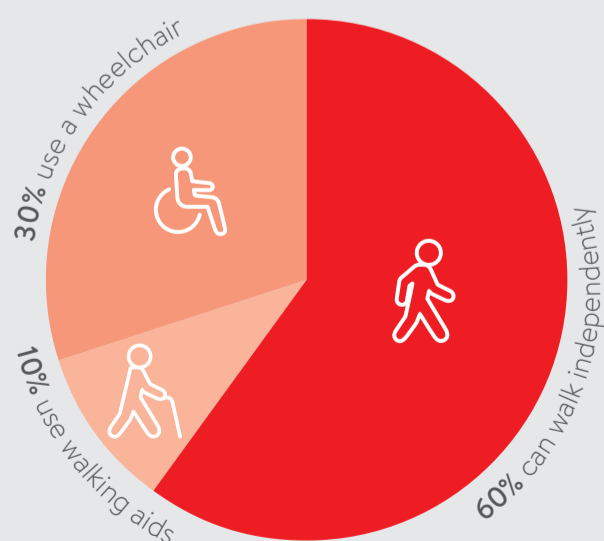


3 in 5
