




Real terms average weekly earnings, Britain, Dec 2009 - Dec 2019





advantages

- Works with manageable number of qualitative cases (from around 12 upwards)
- Allows identification of multiple configurations of causal conditions
- Equifinality of causal conditions
- Asymetric solutions
- The solution contains specific examples allowing further qualitative analysis


