422 deaths each year

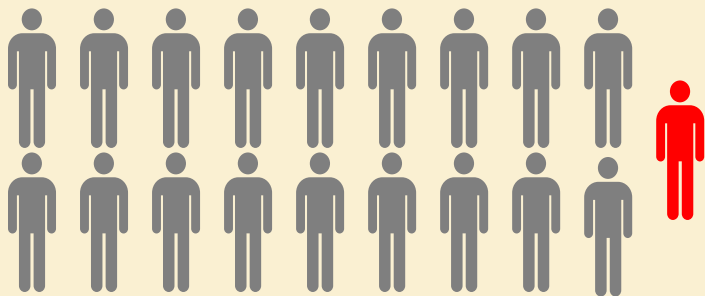
Five-year survival 55%
