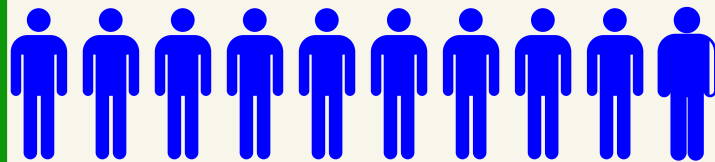

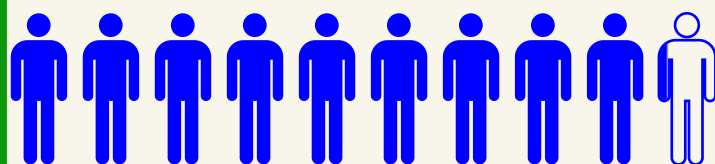

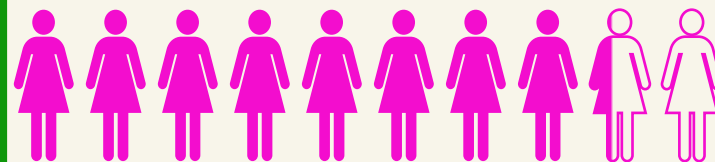

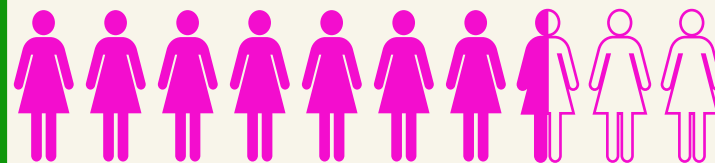

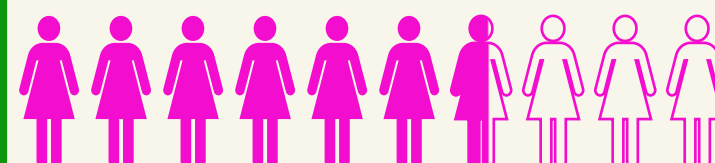

STOMACH CANCER FIVE-YEAR SURVIVAL STILL ONLY 19.4%



PANCREATIC CANCER FIVE-YEAR SURVIVAL STILL ONLY 5.2%



OESOPHAGEAL CANCER FIVE-YEAR SURVIVAL STILL ONLY 17.2%
