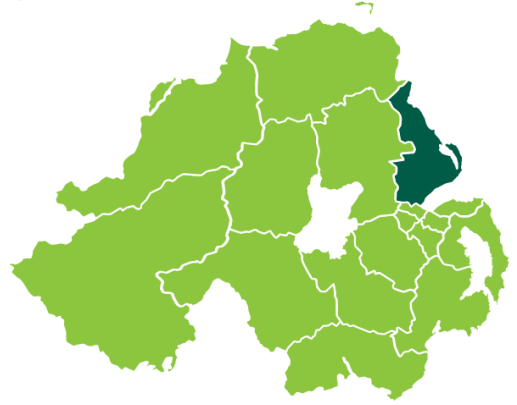


CANCER IN EAST ANTRIM GP FEDERATION

Diagnoses of breast cancer, kidney cancer and melanoma are significantly more common here than across all NI.



Cancer is significantly more common in East Antrim GPF than in all NI.

Average cases 2011-15:

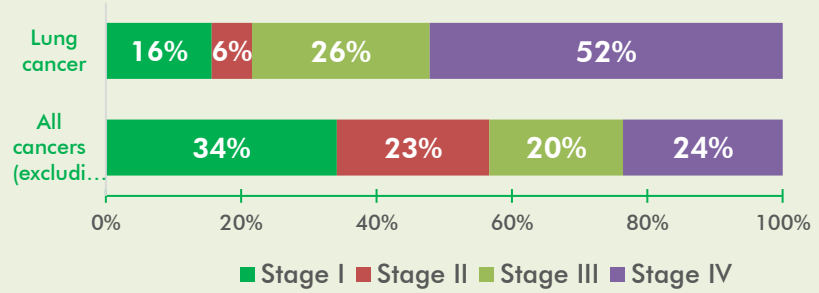

Late diagnosis is much more likely for lung cancer than other cancers.

Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in East Antrim GPF (2011-15)



More than 1 in 3 people living with lung cancer here (35%) had emergency presentations during 2015.

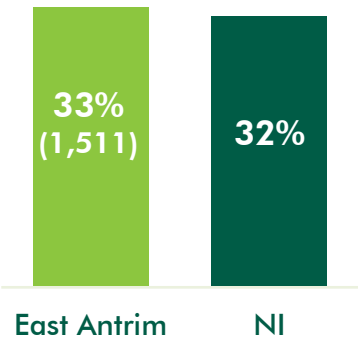
This is much higher than the rate for all of NI (19%).

4,614 people living with cancer up to 23 years at end of 2015 (58,586 NI).
