- More than 1 in 3 prostate cancers (36%) in this area were diagnosed in people of working age (29% in all NI).



Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in Lisburn GPF (2011-15)




The proportion of lung cancer cases diagnosed at Stage IV in Lisburn GP Federation (44%) is significantly lower than across all of Northern Ireland (50%).
