

# CANCER IN MID ULSTER GP FEDERATION

This area has the highest age-standardised incidence of prostate cancer of all GP Federations in Northern Ireland.



Cancer is much less common in Mid Ulster GPF than in all of NI.

Average cases 2011-15:

**348** Mid Ulster GPF

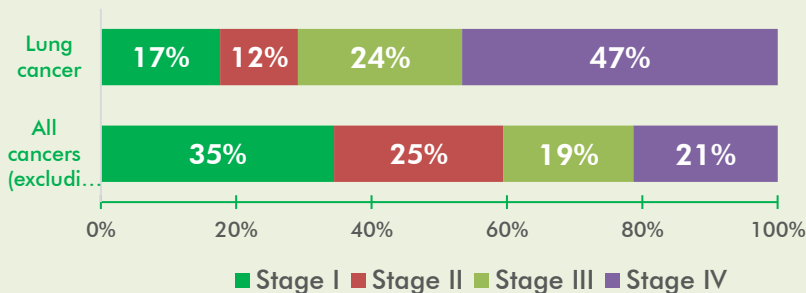

Late diagnosis is much more likely for lung cancer than other cancers.

Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in Mid Ulster GPF (2011-15)



More than 1 in 3 (34%) of people with lung cancer here had emergency presentations in 2015.

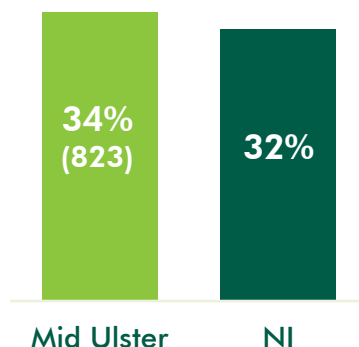
This is much higher than the rate for all of Northern Ireland (19%).
