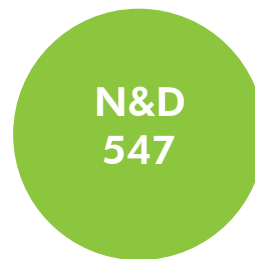
Diagnoses of stomach cancer are significantly more common here than across all NI.

468 Newry & District GPF

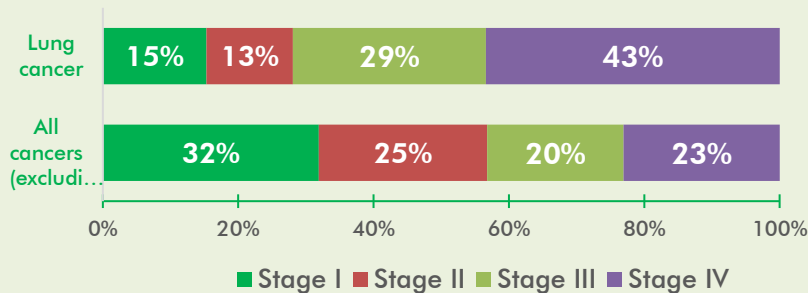

Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in Newry & District GPF (2011-15)



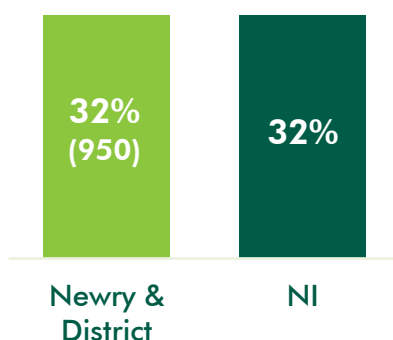
Half of lung cancer cases (50%) in Newry & District were diagnosed in people under the age of 70. This is higher than the rate for all Northern Ireland (42%).
