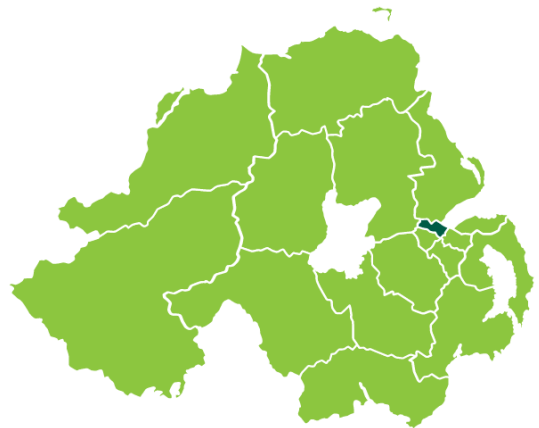


CANCER IN NORTH BELFAST GP FEDERATION

This area has the highest incidence of breast cancer, bladder cancer, and head and neck cancer of all GP Federations. Stomach cancer is also much more common here than across the rest of NI.

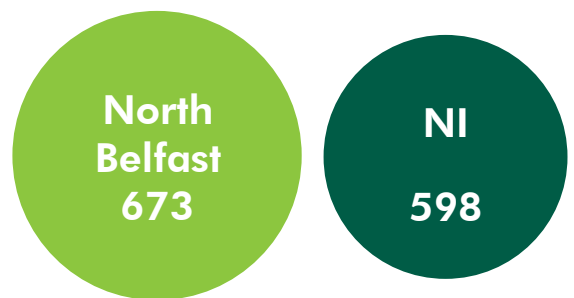


Cancer is much more common in North Belfast GPF than in all NI.

626 North Belfast GPF

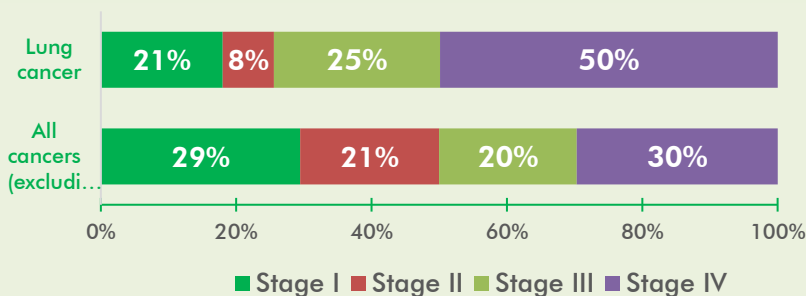

Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in North Belfast GPF (2011-15)



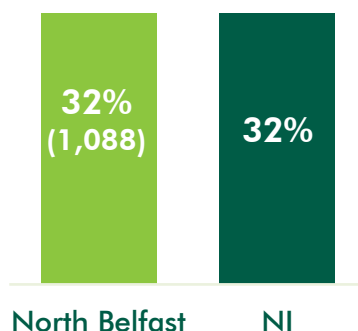
The incidence rate of lung cancer here is the second highest in NI, and is much higher than the rate for all of Northern Ireland.
