

CANCER IN SOUTH WEST GP FEDERATION

Diagnoses of and prostate cancer are significantly more common here than across all NI. The incidence rate is second highest of all GP Federations.



Cancer is as common in South West GPF as it is across all of NI.

543 South Belfast GPF

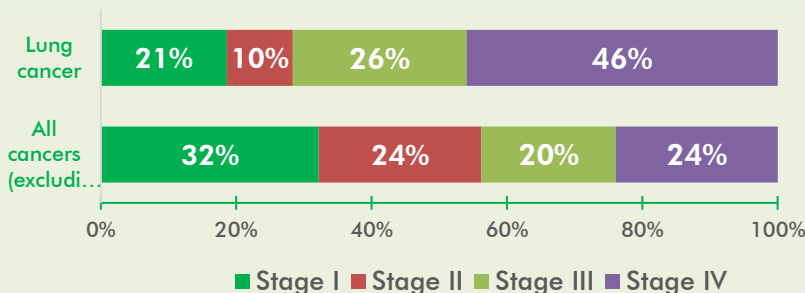

Late diagnosis is much more likely for lung cancer than other cancers.

Known stage at diagnosis for cancers in South West GPF (2011-15)



More than 1 in 4 cases of lung cancer (26%) were diagnosed at Stage I or II.

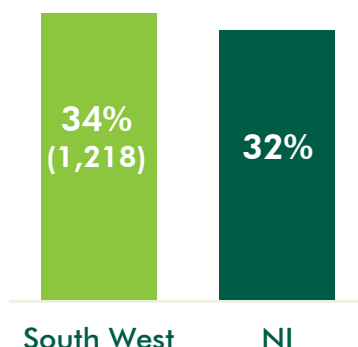
This is higher than the rate for all of Northern Ireland (22%).
