Conclusion	This study used questionnaire response from 13,097 men treated with Androgen Deprivation Therapy for Prostate Cancer diagnosed aged 18-42 months previously. It found while the majority of men treated with ADT did not report poor psychological outcomes, a small proportion reported severe problems. Clinically significant fatigue was demonstrated as a possible indicator of poor outcomes.
What this means for the service	Healthcare systems need to have clear protocols in place which specifically and routinely target psychological distress and fatigue.
