EXAMINATION GUIDELINES

**Please ensure that you read these guidelines before you read the questions.**

1. Rough work must not be written on the Answer Book but on spare paper which may be obtained from the invigilators.
2. You must not put your **name** on any part of the answer book.
3. **You should mark your answers using an HB pencil.** If you do not your answer may not be recorded.
4. **You must stop immediately upon being told to do so at the end of the examination. You must not make any marks on your paper after you have been told to stop.**
5. Marks may be deducted if these examination guidelines and the individual question guidelines are not followed.

**NUMERACY PAPER**

Your answer book contains 8 questions. In respect of each question you should work out what you believe to be the correct answer. **Each correctly identified answer will be awarded 2 marks.**

The answer book contains five possible answers in respect of each question. You should place an "x" in the box next to the answer which you believe to be correct. With the exception of your examination number you should not make any other marks on the answer book.

**Rounding up** – Your final answer to each question must be calculated to two decimal places. Where, in your final answer to each question, the third decimal place is 5 and above it is to be rounded up.

Example:

Question – If interest charged on a loan is £293.21 per annum what is the interest charged on the loan for 50 days?

$$293.21 \div 365 = 0.803315$$

$$0.803315 \times 50 = 40.16575$$

Final answer is 40.17

## **SPELLING, GRAMMAR & PUNCTUATION PAPER**

Your answer book contains a short extract of text which contains 16 errors in either grammar, spelling, punctuation or use of homophones.

You should place an "x" in the box next to the line of text which you believe contains an error. **Each correctly identified error will be awarded 1 mark.**

**In the event you place in excess of 16 "x" on your answer booklet, only the first 16 "x" will be marked.**

With the exception of your examination number you should not make any other marks on the answer book.
