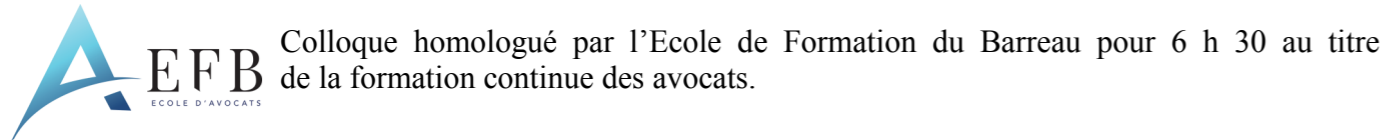


Attendance at the Colloquium may qualify for 6.5 hours CPD.
