THE KATHLEEN SHOTT SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship has been created to celebrate and remember Mrs Kathleen Shott (nee Herald), a much-loved wife, mother and grandmother. Mrs Shott was an alumna of Queen's who graduated with a First Class Honours in Mathematics in 1960 having resided at Riddel Hall whilst studying. Mrs Shott furthered her career as a Maths teacher in post primary and in third level education.

She firmly believed in the transformative power of education and held the subject area of Mathematics close to her heart.

This scholarship has been established to support and encourage young people from a Widening Participation background who have been accepted onto an undergraduate degree in the School of Mathematics and Physics.

Each year up to two scholarships of £30,000 (£10,000 per year for three years per student) will be awarded to First Year students.
