Catherine is Dean for International Affairs and Professor of Political Science at Bocconi University. At Bocconi, she is also a Research Associate at the Dondena Centre for Research on Social Dynamics and Public Policy, the CLEAN Unit for the Economic Analysis of Crime of the BAFFI-CAREFIN research centre and the Bocconi COVID crisis. Catherine's work can be broadly situated in the areas political behaviour, political economy and EU politics. Catherine's work has appeared in leading political science journals, such as the American Political Science Review, Annual Review of Political Science, and she has published several books with top university presses. She is currently working on a research project funded through a Consolidator grant of the European Research Council that examines how economic hardship affects support for socially conservative political agendas.
