The NI and UK job market -Nisra Stats

- NISRA, acting on behalf of the Department for the Economy, received confirmation that 40 redundancies occurred in February 2022.
- Employee indicators remain positive with pay rolled employees, payroll earnings and number of employee jobs (as reported by businesses) all above the pre-pandemic level.
- Rundancies at 64% less than in the previous year.
- December 2021 marked the fourth consecutive quarterly increase in employee jobs, following four previous quarters of decline.
- Private sector jobs increased over both the quarter to 563,940 jobs in December 2021.
- Public sector jobs also increased over both the quarter to 217,790 jobs in December 2021



A 2.2 Honours degree or above, or equivalent qualification acceptable to the University in a cognate area or equivalent professional qualification(s) and at least two years clinical practice experience in a statutory or independent mental health or related setting. All applicants must:

- Provide evidence of prior basic knowledge of psychological therapies preferably Cognitive Behavioural Therapy (CBT), and
- Be currently employed in a clinical or practice setting within an organisation providing therapeutic or counselling services, and
- Be in a role for the duration of the Programme to access a suitable client group for practice and supervision purposes.

Applicants from a non-core profession must provide a portfolio of evidence and references to demonstrate suitable core knowledge, skills and attitudes in line with KSA guidelines produced by The British Association for Behavioural & Cognitive Psychotherapies (BABCP).

All eligible applicants will be interviewed.

Progression from the Postgraduate Diploma (PG Dip) onto the MSc will be subject to successfully completing all PG Dip modules and assessment of suitability for study of research methods and advanced CBT practice, which must be approved by the Course Director.

As a small centre who appreciates voluntary work, this year we are able to offer two scholarship places – one for each of our training courses.

CERTIFICATE TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP

Belfast Cognitive Therapy Centre is the **sole** British Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy (BACP) accredited counsellor/ therapist training programme in Northern Ireland.

We greatly admire voluntary workers and therefore wish to offer a £1500 scholarship to one volunteer, who works with a registered charity or community organisation helping others, to begin to train professionally on our Certificate in CBT.

The certificate is an introductory 12 week course which attracts entrants who wish to train professionally one day. It also attracts those who have no formal qualifications who wish to learn about CBT as well as use the skills learnt to enhance their supportive work done in the local community.

Trainees attend each Saturday from September to December 2018 and will meet with other friendly and helpful peers and training staff who also strongly believe in the value of self-help, empathy and voluntary work.

Applicants are asked only to:

- > One off payment of examination fees of £350 may be paid in installments
- > Attendance at three information evenings per year
- > Help the Centre with some PR
- > Interview fee of £50




