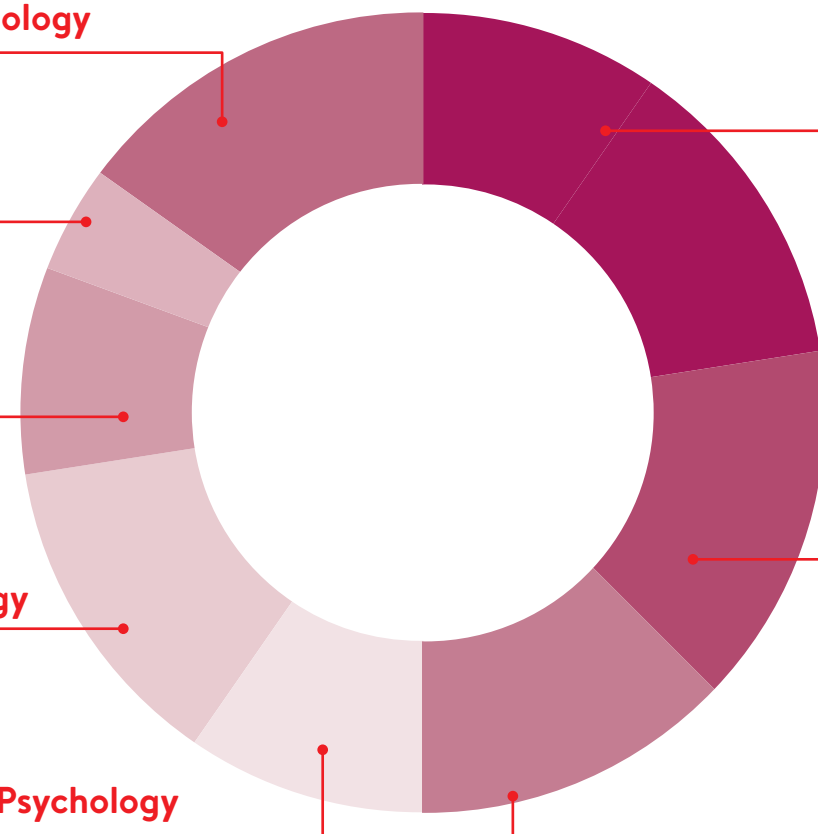

Or you could return to your existing job with a valuable qualification and a greater understanding of what underpins the world around you.

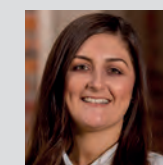
Accreditation

Approved and accredited by the British Psychological Society (it confers the graduate basis for Chartered membership) which means you'll have the essential knowledge to undertake professional training.

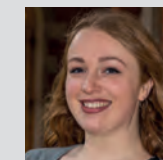
