The Seamus Heaney Centre for Poetry offers an intensive week of creative practice in the Poetry Summer School 2014 which runs from June 23-27, 2014.


The week comprises a variety of sessions with seminars, group workshops and one-to-one tutorials with creative writing tutors. There will also be staff and student poetry readings.
