Queens University is committed to providing excellent services and support to students and to find ways to continually improve these. A primary principle and enabler in this process is the University's engagement with students across the spectrum, including communication with students, learning and teaching and assessment and feedback.

In the drive for improvement and alignment with sector best practice, the University has established the Student Partnership Project Group with the purpose of developing a Framework for effectively engaging students and staff in learning and teaching partnership.

Your feedback and input is essential to understanding where we are effectively engaging with students and where we can do better. The Group has designed a survey to obtain both staff and student views on different aspects of engagement. 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The Student Partnership Project Group consists of staff and student representatives. The survey has been designed to ask the most pertinent questions about key elements of the University's current engagement processes whilst also providing an opportunity for both staff and students to highlight existing examples of best practice in the University and to suggest ways in which other aspects might be improved.

The feedback collated from both students and staff will inform development of a Framework which identifies targeted areas for improvement and which allows us to build on existing good principles and practice. The Framework will be considered by the Education Committee and the Research and Postgraduate Committee to support its implementation and profile as a priority for the University.
