Invariably whenever I perform literature searches the most useful papers prove difficult to find in full print. The AFBI library staff are always able to deliver the literature I need and always very quickly, often without even having to resort to expensive inter-library loans which would otherwise be my only other option.	The AFBI library's document request system is extremely convenient in that it automatically populates a request with all the information which might help the library staff member locate the article. The library staff members employ their expertise and search the least costly routes first and have always managed to find the articles I have needed.
