Brief Summary:

Monitoring was carried out within the confines of Enniskillen Castle (FER 211:039) in advance of the erection of a temporary marquee. The original methodology stipulated the drilling of a series of 8 support holes to a depth of 0.4m for the marquee to be tied into. However, the weather conditions on the day of monitoring meant that an electric drill could not be utilized, and it was decided that adequate support would be provided by driving 0.5m iron pins through the concrete surface of the car park. As such, no invasive groundworks was carried out at the site that required archaeological monitoring.

Supervision of all invasive ground works associated with the erection of a temporary marquee.

Summary

The work carried out at Enniskillen castle did not involve any significant invasive groundworks and therefore archaeological monitoring was not deemed necessary.
