



University Health Centre Queen's University Belfast

The University Health Centre at Queen's is a General practice that provides both student-focused and general National Health services. They also provide University-funded, non-NHS services, for students of Queen's.

Their dedicated team of doctors and nurses have extensive experience in the health needs of young adults with special interests in sports medicine, mental health, and sexual health including family planning, travel and health promotion.

General Information

The Health Centre operate a two week rolling release of routine appointments with their doctors.

They have phone access to a Duty Doctor for urgent medical queries from 8.30 to 11.00. They also have a Doctor who will deal with medical emergencies both morning and afternoon.

Please note that the reception closes from 12.30 to 13.30 each day.

Tuesday - Friday: 10.00-12.30 & 13.30-15.00

You must be registered with the practice in order to seek medical care and have more than 3 months left on your visa.

If you seek medical care privately and have private medical insurance. Your insurance provider may be able to assist with fee.

Please bring your BRP, passport, student card and address details to your appointment.

Please note: It will take approximately 6 weeks to get your NHS card.
