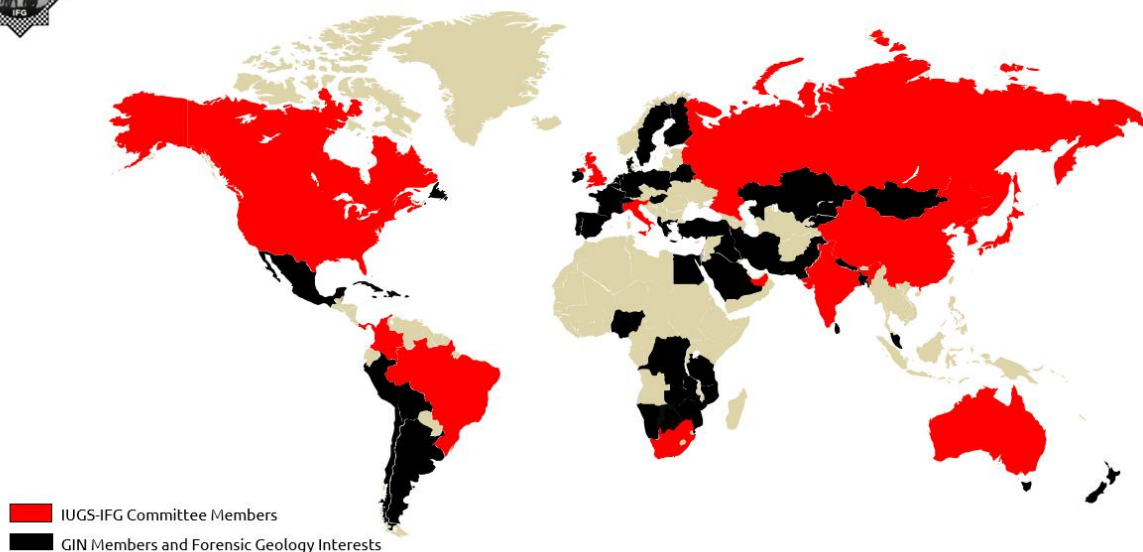
Geoforensic International Network (GIN)
