#### Marie Curie ITN 2016

Queen's submitted **30 applications** to the 2016 ITN Call. A total of 1611 proposals were submitted to the 2016 Call across the EU (a slight increase on the 1567 proposals submitted in 2015).

## Internal process for the submission of Horizon 2020 applications

The Research & Enterprise and Finances Directorates developed a <u>detailed internal process</u> on how to prepare a Horizon 2020 application at Queen's. This process is compulsory for all Horizon 2020 applications.

#### FP7 - Additional funding for Open Access

The European Commission launched the <u>FP7 Post-Grant Open Access Pilot</u> early in 2015, to fund Open Access publishing fees for publications arising from finished FP7 projects through the OpenAIRE project. This Pilot provides funding for Article Processing Charges (APCs) and for Book Processing Charges (BPCs) for FP7 projects up to two years after they have ended.
