Timeline for Friday 22nd March:

Section 1: Victoria Park to C.S. Lewis Square 8am

Please meet beside the car park at Victoria Park, where you will be accompanied along the Greenway as we travel to C.S. Lewis Square, setting off at approximately 8.15am. This section is approximately 1.4km long. Please see the <u>link here</u> for a google map pin of the departure location.

Section 2: C.S. Lewis Square to Dixon Playing Fields 9:30am

We will depart the Build East Pavilion at C.S. Lewis Square to make our way to Linen Gardens at Dixon Playing Fields, through the Hollow. An accessible toilet (accessed via a lift in Jack's cafe) and car parking (by Holywood Arches Health Centre) are available at C.S. Lewis Square. Section 1: Dixon Playing Fields to Orangefield Park 9am
