

Bach-ts

What it is, and what it does

Bach-ts is a font designed to extend the range of time-signature-related symbols contained in the **Bach** font. It's features are summarised as follows:

- it retains all the time-signature-related symbols in the original design of the **Bach** font
- it contains the new symbols to make any numeric key-signatures containing digits 1 - 24
- all the upper numbers 1-24 are now accessible from keyboard:
 - a. 1-10 by holding SHIFT + number (10 for 0; I also assumes that you have a UK keyboard)
 - b. 11-20 by holding SHIFT + Q,W,E,R,T,Y,U,I,O,P
 - c. 21-24 by holding SHIFT + A,S,D,F
- all the lower numbers 1-24 are also accessible from keyboard: simply press the key **without** the SHIFT key described above.
- all the numbers are re-touched, now showing better vertical alignment.

When typing the numbers, ensure that you type the upper number first, followed by the lower number. Otherwise the time-signature will not stack up correctly.

Special Notes for non-UK keyboard users

This font was created with UK keyboard layout in mind. See the following conversion table for reference.
